

Scheduling A Thinking Generation Seminar

The needs and costs involved with scheduling and hosting a seminar by Joshua White

Travel Costs

We ask that all travel costs are covered. This includes mileage for driving, flights, parking at the airport, rental car and fuel, food, hotel stay, etc.

If driving in the USA – \$0.67/mile

If flying – cost of airline ticket and any other expenses involved.

If flying, Joshua is willing to either be picked up at the airport upon arrival or to rent a car. Please advise your preference.

Honorarium/Speaking Fee

The honorarium is an important means of support for the ministry and helps cover incidental costs of Joshua's travel.

The honorarium is \$400 as a base fee per event up to 2 days. Additional days are \$100/day.

Examples:

- Friday and Sabbath seminar = \$400
- Friday through Sunday seminar = \$500
- Five-day seminar = \$700

In addition to the honorarium, a freewill offering or donation for the support of the ministry is always welcome.

ATG is also supported through the sale of books, DVDs, and other materials. If there will not be an opportunity for selling these materials, the honorarium may need to be adjusted.

Hospitality

Joshua is happy to stay in a church member's home or in separate lodging such as a hotel. If possible, a table and chair at which he can work and study is appreciated. Please keep in mind his need for rest and time for prayer and preparation of the messages.

Meals

Joshua eats a completely plant-based diet and is quite happy with simple food. He enjoys an abundance of fresh fruit!

He prefers to avoid items prepared with vinegar, baking soda/powder, or sugar and other sweeteners. He also tries to avoid, or at least minimize, all types of oil.

He usually eats a light supper of fruit and bread.

If Joshua is staying in a hotel, please bear in mind that hotels do not usually provide a healthy breakfast. There may be need for Joshua to purchase some food and incur some extra expense.
